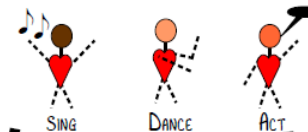

Bippie's Magic

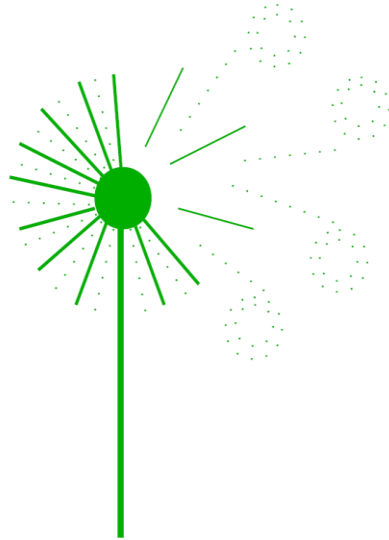

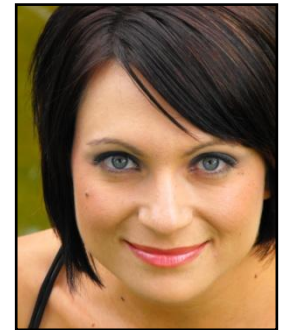
